Point of Law :- When a complaint petition is transmitted by the Magistrate to the police station u/s 156(3) of the Cr.P.C, police can not decide not to conduct investigation on the ground of territorial jurisdiction.

"The Supreme Court held the Investigation Agency was required to place the facts elicited during the investigation before the Court in order to enable the court

the Investigating Agency to forward its report with the observation that since the entire cause of action for the alleged offence had purportedly arisen in the city of Mumbai within the State of Maharashtra, the investigation should be transferred to the concerned Police Station in Mumbai. Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. contemplates a stage where the Learned Magistrate is not convinced as to whether process should issue on the facts disclosed in the complaint. Once the facts are received, it is for the Magistrate to decide his next course of action. In this case, there are materials to show that the appellant had filed his application for loan with the Head Office of the Bank at Ahmedabad and that the processing and the sanction of the loan was also done in Ahmedabad which clearly indicates that the major part of the cause of action for the complaints arose within the jurisdiction of the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Ahmedabad. It was not, therefore, desirable on the part of the Investigation Agency to make an observation that it did not have territorial jurisdiction to proceed with the investigation, which was required to be transferred to the Police Station having jurisdiction to do so."

(2) AIR 2010 SUPREME, COURT 1974 (From: Karnataka)

K G BALAKRISHNAN, C.J.I., RV. RAVEENDRAN AND J.M. PANCHAL, JJ.

Smt. Selvi & Ors. - Vrs. - State of Karnataka.

Point of Law :- DNA profiling of the accused is expressly permitted by Sec- 53 of the Cr.P.C. Bar under Article 20(3) of Constitution of India does not apply since it is not a testimonial act.

In the present case, written submissions made on behalf of the respondents have tried to liken the compulsory administration of the impugned technique with the DNA profiling technique. In light of this attempted analogy, we must stress that the DNA profiling technique has been expressly included among the various forms of medical examination in the amended explanation to Sections 53,53-a and 54 of the Cr.P.C It must be clarified that a 'DNA profile' is different from a DNA sample which can be obtained from bodily substances. A DNA profile is a record created on the basis of DNA samples made available to forensic experts. Creating and maintaining DNA profiles of offenders and suspects are useful; practices since newly obtained DNA samples can be readily matched with existing profiles that are already in the possession of law enforcement agencies. The machine of DNA samples is emerging as a vital tool for linking suspects to specific criminal acts. It may also be recalled that as per the majority decision in Kathi Kahu Oghad, (AIR 1961 SC 1808)(supra) the use of material samples such as fingerprints for the purpose of comparison and identification does not amount to a testimonial act for the purpose of article 20(3). Hence, the taking and retention of DNA samples which are in the nature of physical evidence does not face constitutional hurdles in the Indian context. However, if the DNA profiling technique is further developed and used for testimonial purposes, then such uses in the future could face challenges in the judicial domain.

(3) The Judgement dated 19/04/2010 passed by the Division Bench of the Supreme Court of India in WP (C) No 14 of 2008. (General Insurance Council & Ors-vs- State of AP & Ors) in respect of dealing with seized vehicles as follows.

1) In case where the seized vehicle is not claimed by the accused, owner or the

- 2) If the said vehicle is insured with the insurance company then the insurance company be informed by the court to take possession of the vehicle which is not claimed by the owner or a third person.
- 3) If the insurance company fails to take possession, the vehicle may be sold as per the direction of the court.
- 4) The court would pass such order within a period of six months from the date of production of the said vehicle before the court.
- 5) In any case, before handing over possession of such vehicles, appropriate photographs of the said vehicle should be taken and detailed panchnama should be prepared.

But the said directions have not been full and complete compliance. Therefore, this court in addition to earlier orders has issued further following directions in WP (C) No. 14 of 2008 so the national waste with regard to the seized vehicles involved in commission of various offences may not become junk and their road worthiness be maintained.

- 1) Powers u/s 451/457 CrPC should be exercised expeditiously & judiciously.
- 2) Court or the police would not be required to keep the articles in safe custody.
- 3) If the proper panchnama before handing over possession of the articles is prepared, that can be used in evidence instead of its production before the court during the trial.
- 4) Periodical checking shall be done by the IGP concerned to ensure that the requirements are being complied with.
- 5) In case there is non-compliance, appropriate action shall be taken against the erring officials.
- 6) The photograph may be taken duly authenticated and certified, and a detailed panchnama may be prepared before such release. The photographs so taken may be used as secondary evidence during trial.
- 7) DGP's of the slate shall ensure macro implementation of the statutory provisions and further direct that the activities of every PS's with regard to disposal of seized vehicles be taken care of by IGP/SP of the concerned districts.

This refers to Barasat PS Case No. 544 dt. 01/04/2011 u/s 63/65 Copy Right Act 1957 and read with sec. 420 / 120B IPC.
- (ii). On 16/04/2011 in course of inspection of a shop of one Dhananjoy @ Partha Halder styled as Ma Laxmi Variety Store at Canning Ferry Ghat Road, by E.B. Officers & men along with authorised representatives of Always Detective Service Pvt. Ltd.
